Australian manuals (very different from modern bushdance forms): the Vals à trois temps, the Vals à deux temps, the new Vals à trois temps, the 'Spring' or 'Hop' waltz, the 'New Waltz', the Polka mazurka, the Mazurka vals / Waltz mazurka, the Varsovienna, the German finger polka, the Melbourne polka, and the Polka Galop.
